International Pentecostal–Anglican Commission (IPAC)

Calgary, Canada. 6 – 12 June 2026



The final annual meeting of the International Pentecostal–Anglican Commission (IPAC) took place at Journey Church, Calgary, Canada between 6 and 12 June 2026.

The Commission has been completing its first mandate from the Anglican Communion and the Pentecostal World Fellowship (PWF) on the subject of Transforming Holiness. The Commission heard stories and examples of the relationship between Anglicans and Pentecostals in different parts of the world. The meeting was hosted by the PWF. The Commission enjoyed morning and evening prayer, led alternately by members of each team, and an Anglican rite Eucharist on Sunday.

The Commission made much progress on its common statement, and the last pieces will be put in place over the coming months. This will enable the Commission to publish its report and present it to their authorising bodies.



The Commission attended Sunday morning worship at Jubilee Church, and is grateful to Pastor Jess DiSabatino and Pastor David DiSabatino for the hospitality provided by the church and for a place to meet and work.

IPAC was delighted to spend time in conversation with not only the local Pentecostal team, but also with the Most Revd Greg Kerr-Wilson and the Revd Dr Dane Neufeld, hearing about the life of the churches in Canada, and sharing insights that relate very much to the work of IPAC as well.
